Children from Year 3 and 4 represented the school well at this week's football tournament. They showed lots of excellent football skills and came third in their group. What a great achievement! A huge congratulations to those children!



Forest School - Year 5

Year 5 have been learning about space during their Forest School session this week. They started by telling each other a fact they already knew or something they would like to learn. The first activity was to create a scale model of our solar system using pictures of the planets, string and measuring rulers or tapes. They had to work out which planet was which and then measure the distances from the Sun and place them in the correct place along the string. They all did a great job and made some interesting observations.

They noticed that the solid planets were closer to the sun and the gas giants were further away. They also noticed that the planets closer to the sun were closer to each other than the ones further away. After making their scale model, they all created their own versions of a planet or the solar system using natural materials. They showed amazing creativity and there was a variety of different approaches used. Jupiter was the most popular planet recreated, with particular attention paid to the big red spot.









In the Summer term, Lili planted a pumpkin seed which she left to grow in our outdoor area. Over the last few months, it has grown and Lili was able to harvest her pumpkin yesterday on Halloween. Lili was surprised that it was not a circle shape.
