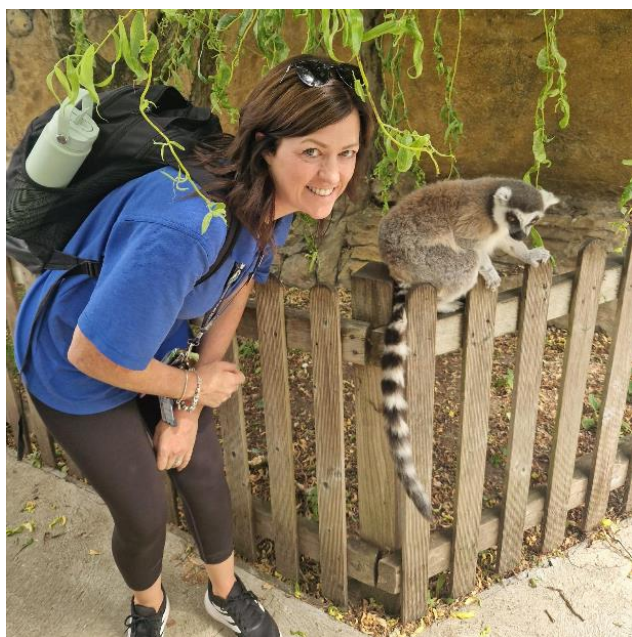
It was wonderful to see the children enjoying every moment and sharing all their learning with such excitement.

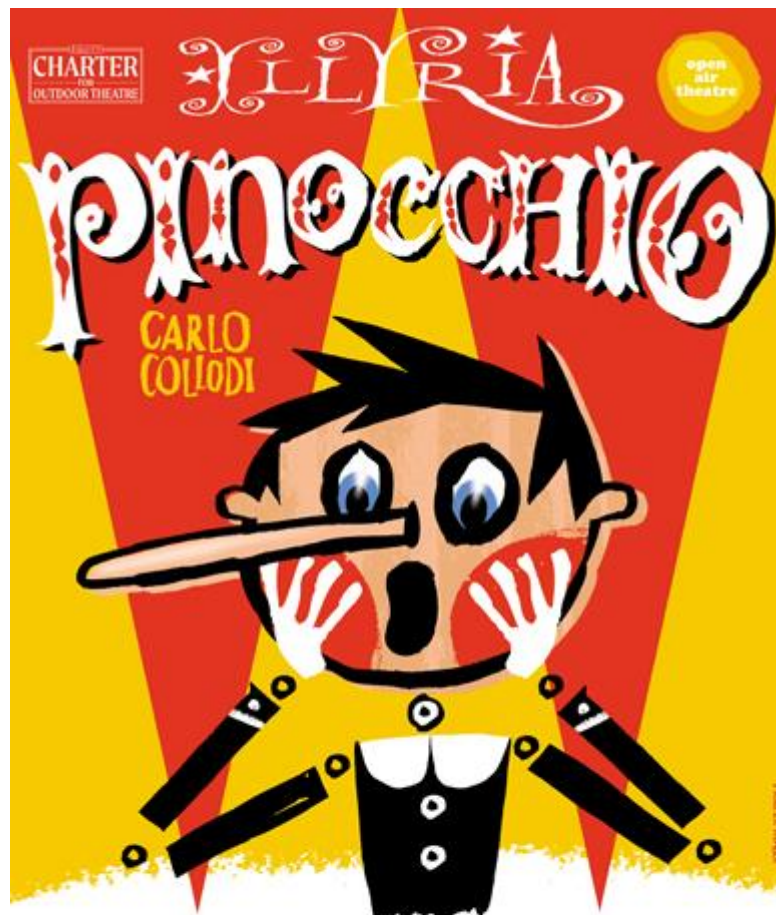
