Young Voices



<u>Rhyme Time:</u> A music and rhyme themed session where children can develop their language and communication skills and be signing along to their favourite songs and nursery rhymes.

<u>Learning Through Play:</u> This session provides a variety of activities for children to explore supporting children's changing needs and interests, the session offers an opportunity for parents, carers and children to discover and explore a wide range of play activities together, encouraging children's independence, confidence and social skills.

<u>Stay & Play under 1's:</u> This session aims to support developing babies to grow and learn. Activities will encourage babies to reach their unique developmental milestones, following their interests and curiosities.
