Do you find your child's behaviour puzzling or frustrating on occasions?

Angela Pinchin, Pupil Wellbeing Lead and Jacqueline Clark, Family Liaison Support, at Bourne Westfield Primary Academy, are planning another course titled 'Understanding Your Child'. All parents may benefit from this reflective course that covers relationships, managing emotions, reducing conflict, sleep, eating, anxiety, anger tantrums - and of course, boundary battles!

It is a relaxed and accepting environment, suitable for anyone involved with children aged 0 - 18 and everyone is welcome. It will run on a Thursday evening, at Bourne Westfield, from 6.00 - 8.00pm for 7 weeks, commencing 6^{th} June 2024. The cost is £21 (concessions can be discussed with Mrs Clark) and this is payable prior to the course, or £3 per week, whichever you feel would suit you.

Year 1

Today in science, year one first went to check on the vegetables that we planted 2 weeks ago to see if they had started growing and we also watered them. We then started an experiment. We planted four different pots of cress seeds: one which will have sunlight and water, one which will just have sunlight, one which will be kept in the dark and one which will be kept in the dark with water. The children made their predictions as to which pot will grow best. We will update you with the results soon!







<u>Year 2</u>
Many thanks to the Elsea Park Co-op for the wonderful donation of cress seeds, pots, compost and even a bucket and trowels. Year 2 are studying how plants grow in science this term and were excited to get them planted. Each child now has their own pot of cress seeds that they are caring for and observing as they grow.

This week year 5 have been very enthusiastic towards their learning in English. They have been preparing for a debate linking to their geography topic: the resourceful rainforests. Each child was given a different role and had to argue for or against deforestation. The children worked extremely hard with this, whilst having some fantastic questions and answers during their time in the hot seat. They even got to sit in Mr Moutrey's chair! Wonderful work year 5, well done!
