School Lunches - September 2025

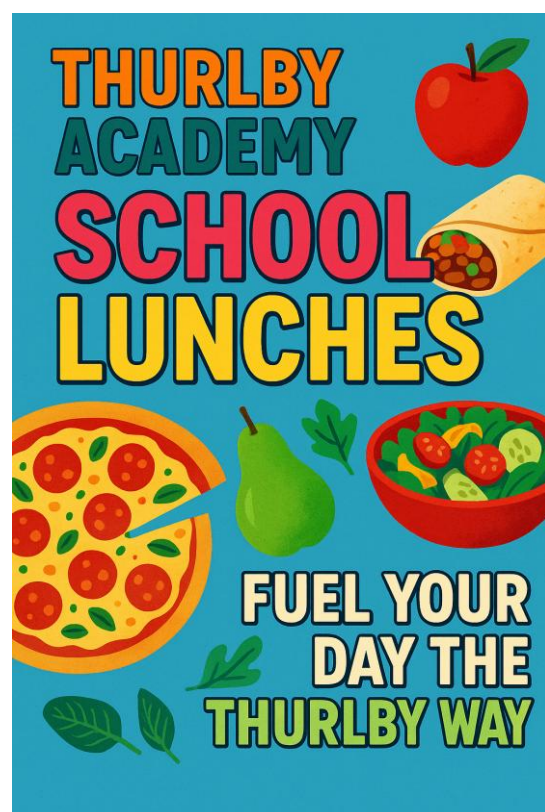
The first term is available on the website, so you can order well in advance. Please be aware that the deadline for ordering meals for the first week of term is **Tuesday 26th August**. All orders, including free school meals, must be placed before the deadline. The kitchen will not be able to accommodate for any unordered meals.

When you next log in to your account, you will be asked to change your child's class to the one they will move up to in September. All other account details will remain the same. If you have a child starting in Reception in September, you can add them to your existing account.

If you have a child currently in Year 2, their Universal Infant Free School Meals will end this July. When they return in September the cost of a meal will be £2.95. If you think your child may qualify for benefit-related Free School Meals you can apply via Lincolnshire County Council's online free school meal application service.
