Reading in Key Stage One (Year 1 and Year 2)

We are keen for our children to engage in daily reading. At the moment, we are focussing on the children settling in happily to their new environment and taking time to assess where they are in terms of phonic knowledge and understanding and general reading ability. With this in mind, the children will not bring home a school reading book on Monday 14th like the rest of the school. We do, however, encourage you to continue enjoying books and stories at home. We will aim to send books home that are both matched to your child's

reading ability and that also provide appropriate challenge by Monday 21st September. Please ensure that books are returned on a Friday ONLY which was stated in the full opening information to parents.

Birthday Treats

Unfortunately, for the time being, we are requesting that children do not bring sweets or any treats in for their class mates on their birthdays. We appreciate that this is a lovely way to celebrate with peers, but, given the current situation, it is necessary to limit items going to and from different households as much as possible. Learning Journals

If your child has not already brought one home, all children will be provided with a new learning journal this week or next. The journals are intended to be both a learning tool for the children and a communication tool for you, so please take time to look through them. The sections which we need you to fill in as soon as possible are the contact details and home collection details in the front of the journal. The journals are for you and your child to fill in as appropriate. Learning journals need to be in school every day as the children will be using them in lessons. Teachers will initial any messages you send in the journal so that you know they have seen them; in this way, we will ensure that no important messages get missed. Please can you ask your child to tell their class teacher that there is a message. Children in Key Stage 2 will be encouraged by their teachers to open their journals up on the correct page each day. Please record every time you read with your child and for the older children please encourage them to record their own reading <u>at least 3 times a week</u>. Reading and vocabulary are still a focus in school so we will be monitoring this regularly.

Premier Education Clubs

Information was sent home on Wednesday regarding the fee-paying after school clubs provided by Premier Education. If your child is participating in any of these clubs, and it is not their normal PE day at school, then they <u>DO NOT</u> need to wear PE kit that day or bring PE kit to school.
