



Shadow and Mrs Breidenbach have been working hard on their training plan and Shadow has progressed in her settle, loose lead walking and greeting politely. At her visit she was introduced to BOWOW (body only without words) by our trainer, Fiona. This is where the handler uses hand signals and body language only to communicate with the dog which is useful when Mrs Breidenbach is talking to a child - she can signal to Shadow without taking her attention from the class. Well done Shadow you're doing so well with your training!






Hot School Meals

Year 5

Year 5 have been looking at physical computing this term using Crumble Kits! The class have learnt how to connect the kit together and then have programmed the Crumble to complete tasks such as changing the colour of an LED sparkle (we turned the classroom into a disco!), getting a motor to spin clockwise and anti-clockwise and using a switch to stop the program they have coded from running. Year 5 are really enjoying this computing module, so keep up the hard work!



Year 6

Breakfast club settled our Year 6 children into school before SATS this week and it was a lovely way to start each day. We are proud of how the children handled the tests with focus and determination. Once the tests were completed, the children started to create their wire sculptures using polystyrene, wire, tinfoil and paverpol - we can't wait to see the final results!
