<u>School Lunches - September 2023</u>

Our new lunch menu for September is now live on the Taylor Shaw website. A copy of the menu has been sent out by Parentmail today and added to the school website. The first term is available on the website, so you can order well in advance. This includes our first 'Theme Day Lunch', a Harvest Lunch on Thursday 5th October.

The deadline for ordering meals for the first week of term is Tuesday 29th August. All orders, including free school meals, must be placed before the deadline - the kitchen will not be able to accommodate for any unordered meals. A pasta pot meal will be ordered for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 where no order has been placed.

When you next log in to your account, you will be asked to change your child's class to the one they will move up to in September. All other account details will remain the same. If you have a child starting in Nursery or Reception in September, you can add them to your existing account. Please note, for pupils who pay for their lunches the cost will increase to $\pounds 2.60$ for a single meal or $\pounds 13.00$ for the week. Our prices have remained stable for some time; however, there has been an increase in ingredients and operational costs.
