Primary Admissions - September 2025

The initial closing date for Reception 2025 applications has now closed. However, Lincolnshire Admissions will accept late applications and changes up until 10th February.

Transport - Primary or Secondary Transfer - September 2025

If your child is starting primary school, or transferring to secondary school, in September 2025, they may be eligible for school transport. If you think your child is eligible, please apply for transport as soon as you have your offer of a school place (3 March for secondary school or 16 April for primary). Early transport applications are encouraged to ensure that transport is in place in time for the start of the September term. Applications can be made online at the website below or a telephone application can be made by contacting the Customer Service Centre on 01522 782020. Please do not apply until you have a formal offer of a school place.

Curriculum Overviews for the Spring Terms


Each year group's curriculum overviews, for terms 3 and 4, are on the website for you to see what your child will be learning across all subjects.





Year 1


Forest School - Year 4
