Reception

In some of our learning this week, we have been making large scale castles and beanstalks to retell the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We looked at which 3D shapes made the best castles to protect the giant's gold. We investigated which shapes balanced the best, which shapes fitted together the best and why and we also looked at why some of the shapes needed to be rotated a certain way to balance better. The cylinders, cones and pyramids had to stand on their flat faces. The spherical shapes were not included as they just rolled away!



Year 2

As part of our science topic of 'How do plants grow?', Year 2 have been observing how plants grow from a seed into a plant. We have been growing lots of seeds but our runner beans are starting to outgrow the classroom! They are now ready to be planted outside.

Can we please ask parents to help their child to plant the bean in a pot or in your garden and support them with a cane or similar item to climb up. Keep the plant watered and it will continue to grow taller and will produce flowers.

Hopefully, the flowers will develop into beans for you to enjoy with your family. It will be lovely if families can keep us updated on how well their plants are growing. 😊



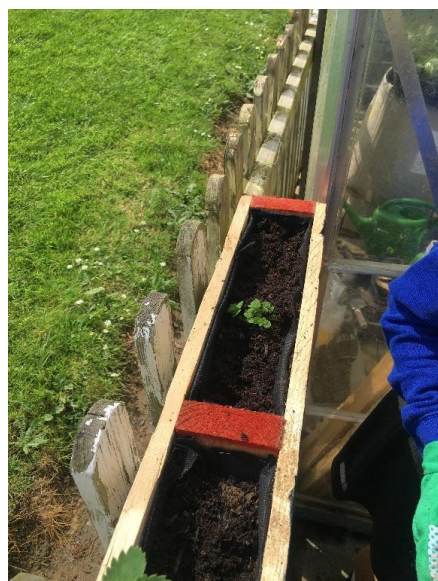
Year 4
