The main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms.

If your child displays any of these, please see the flowchart at the end of this newsletter so that you know what action to take.

School Information

Important - Changes to Pupil Premium Funding Eligibility - Is my child eligible?

Your child may be eligible to get Pupil Premium Funding, to help provide greater support to them in school, if you are in receipt of one or more of the following qualifying benefits:

- <u>Universal Credit</u> (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400 per annum (£616.67 per month)
- Income Support
- Income-based <u>Jobseeker's Allowance</u>
- Income-related <u>Employment and Support Allowance</u>
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state <u>Pension Credit</u>
- <u>Child Tax Credit</u> (provided you're <u>not</u> also entitled to <u>Working Tax Credit</u> and have an annual gross income of no more £16,190 per annum, as assessed by HMRC)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.
