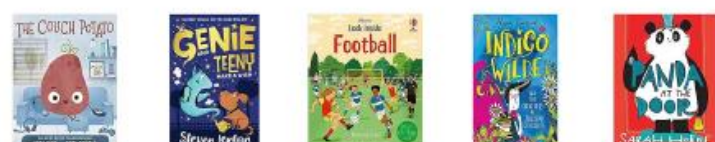
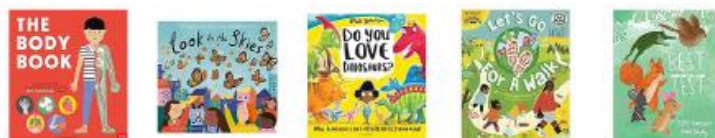

To give you a little more information about what happenings to the bags once collected please see the following extract:

The clothes collected from school are baled into big 'botany bales' and then loaded onto trucks for export. Once they arrive at our customer's factory, they are sorted into 150 different types of clothing depending upon the end market. The clothing will make journeys all over the world starting their new life! This can be a purpose built second hand store in Eastern Europe or South America, or a market stall in East or West Africa, providing valuable employment for importers, warehouse staff, transport companies and stall holders as well as affordable clothes for local people.
