#### Year 2- Visit to Delaine Bus Company

As part of our History topic, exploring our local area and how Delaine Bus company has developed, Year 2 went on an exciting trip to the Delaine Bus Museum. We travelled there and back on a Delaine bus and got to explore a range of buses to see how they had changed over time. Anthony (a family member of Delaine Bus Company) talked to us about how the buses have changed over time and why, along with some interesting facts about how much fuel is used, the routes they take and how we pay for the bus has developed. Our trip ended with the best part of all, we sat on the bus as it went through the bus wash! The children talked about it the next day too.









#### Forest School - Year 1

Wow, what glorious weather Year 1 had for forest school this week, very different to last week! Year 1 have been creating some new habitats for the creatures that visit our outdoor area. We looked at the best place to put our new habitats, thinking about them not being a trip hazard or being at risk of getting knocked down or mistaken for building materials. They all worked really hard collecting the materials and building the new habitats. They created a log pile near the fence by the Year 3/4 gate and a stone pile near the wooden gate to the playground outside Year 4. The children were very excited to see insects coming to their habitats whilst they were making them. The stone pile had 19 visitors by the end of the session. We also filled up bird feeders, made bird food balls and apple bird feeders.
