Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back to the new term!

We have noticed, this week, that some families have forgotten some of our school expectations. Please see below as a reminder:

- Long hair should be tied up (girls / boys)
- Shirts must be tucked in
- School shoes must be worn, every day, apart from PE days
- Necklaces, rings and bracelets must not be worn. Stud earrings can be worn but NOT for PE or swimming days
- Children must NOT bring toys into school
- Children should only bring in a fidget toy if this has been agreed/decided by the class teacher and/or SENCo
- Learning journals must be in school every day - we use these in our lessons
- Water bottles should be a sensible size and only include water (apart from extenuating circumstances that the school are aware of through the correct channels)
- Parents/carers should use the Methodist Church or surrounding roads (not people's driveways) for parking before and after school
- Please book routine appointments during the holidays or after school - not during school time. Having children leaving their lessons to attend routine appointments disrupts the learning for them (often meaning that they do not understand future learning). This then disrupts the flow for others too.
