Online Safety - FREE Event - Information for Parents

In the Keeping Safe Online Survey of 2023, Lincolnshire children, who reported having less parental supervision online, were more likely to report being bullied online. It was discovered that effective parental/guardian supervision of a child's online activity reduced the risk of children being bullied online by up to 39%. The online space can feel overwhelming with new apps and trends, it can be hard to keep up! Therefore, Lincolnshire County Council want to give parents the information and tools to help people to feel confident enough to protect children and young people from online harm.
