## Forest School - Year 6

Last week, Year 6 were learning about different types of nature deities. Miss Titman challenged them to create a nature deity for the villages they created last week. They had to come up with a name, what they were the god of and show or talk about how the village would celebrate them. They all showed great creativity and teamwork. We had Lavous the God of Lava, Peanut the God of Nuts and Pyrus the God of Fire.





This week, Year 6 have been making art inspired by nature, they used natural materials, chalk, crayons, pencils to create some amazing pieces of art. Miss Titman and Mrs Edgar were really impressed with their creativity.









#### Year 2 - English

In a recent English lesson, we explored a poem called 'Mum'. We listened to a poet reading the poem and then read the poem ourselves. We counted the beat in each line of the poem and discussed any differences across the verses. Then we learnt the poem to perform, following the rhythm of the poem. We performed in small groups to each other and gave brilliant constructive feedback.

## Year 4 - Dance

This week in Year 5, the children had a brilliant experience through Now Press Play (an interactive tool used to support writing). They fully immersed themselves back in Victorian times, following the story of a Victorian child. The listening and co-operation were fantastic while they demonstrated some excellent retrieval knowledge, using a reading comprehension follow-up activity.






#### Christmas Event
