Year 1 - Forest School

This was our final week, one of warm sunshine and fun outdoor learning. Once again, we used all our senses in each task:

- Warm up games
- Smelling and tasting a range of garden herbs
- Feeling the trees and doing some amazing bark rubbing art
- Listening to the trees hearing the water move within a tree using a stethoscope
- Seeing things in the forest school area by taking part in a colour scavenger hunt









Year 2

In science, Year 2 have been learning about food chains. We talked about the scientist Rachel Carson and the important work she has done involving food chains. We completed an experiment, like Rachel's, to discuss her findings. Rachel found that chemicals used in some pesticides were making their way into sea habitats and their food chains. We used skittles to show what happened to the pesticides used on land when it rained. We talked about Rachel's findings and how her work changed some pesticide use and helped our environment.

All the weekly menus for next term are now available on the Taylor Shaw meals website, so you can order well in advance.



There are lots of clubs and events taking place during the easter holidays. The following pages advertise a few of the activities on offer in our area:




Funtopia
