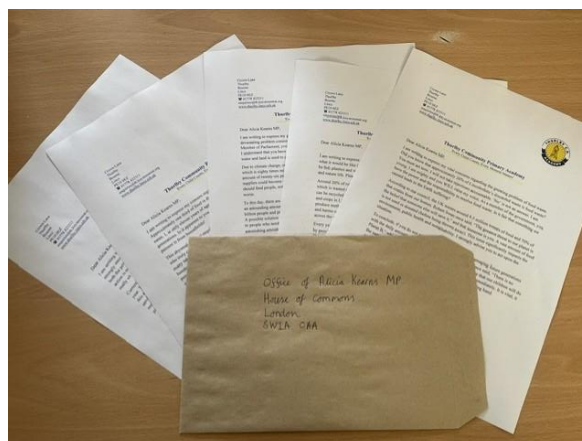


Year 6 Find Their Voice
