We learnt about the fire triangle and how this helps us to understand how the fire spread. We used flint and steel to make sparks, built a fire and even toasted marshmallows. After the fire was safely out, we used the cooled charcoal to write and draw pictures of fire on the paving slabs.



**Growing Talk:** Have fun together at Growing Talk, where your child will meet Mikey, our Growing Talk puppet, play with sounds, sprinkle magic and go flying on a carpet. This fun session focuses on enhancing children's communication and language development and growing children's 'talk'.

**Rhyme Time:** A music and rhyme themed session where children can develop their language and communication skills and be signing along to their favourite songs and nursery rhymes.

**Let's Get Active:** This is a fun active session offering a variety of activities to support children's physical development and promote a healthy life style. During the session a variety of fun learning opportunities will be offered to support the development of children's gross motor skills, co-ordination and teach them that being active is fun!

**Skills Development Service – How Can We Help?** Find out how we can support parents with their own Confidence Building, Adult Learning, Volunteering and Employment.

**Toddler Outdoor Group – Let's Get Active:** This is a fun active session offering a variety of activities to support children's physical development and promote a healthy life style. During the session a variety of fun learning opportunities will be offered to support the development of children's gross motor skills, co-ordination and teach them that being active is fun!

**Learning Through Play:** This session provides a variety of activities for children to explore supporting children's changing needs and interests, the session offers an opportunity for parents, carers and children to discover and explore a wide range of play activities together, encouraging children's independence, confidence and social skills.

**Stay & Play under 1's:** This session aims to support developing babies to grow and learn. Activities will encourage babies to reach their unique developmental milestones, following their interests and curiosities.

**Learning Together:** Learning together offers a variety of activities as well as a Talk Time, songs and stories to support children's development, by building their confidence as they learn to explore.
