Thank you ever so much to Mrs Sewell for organising this day and ensuring that it was highly organised and a lot of fun for all! 😊

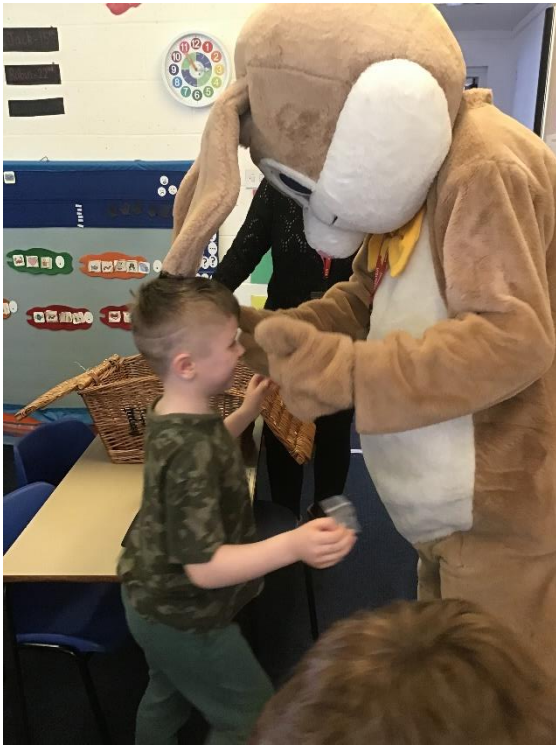


PTFA Spring Dress Down Day

As advised via MCAS today, next term, EYFS and Year 4 will be having Forest School on Thursday afternoons as detailed below.

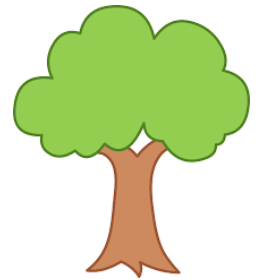
Forest School
