Dear Parents.

Shotbowl is ready for the 'Back to School' season and we would like to tell you about the key dates to help everything run as smoothly as possible.

CURRENT SERVICE UNTIL FRIDAY 12th JULY 2024

You can order on-line and choose either home delivery (free if you spend over £75) or use our in-store Click & Collect service.

The shop is open for over the counter sales, if you need to try items on you will require a sizing appointment which are available to book. At the 30 minute appointment uniform can be tried on and you can buy on the day. It is really helpful if you can measure your child prior to your appointment – chest/bust, waist and inside leg.

FROM SATURDAY 13thth JULY 2024

We will revert to on-line sales for Home Delivery or in-store Click & Collect only.

We will not be able to sell school uniform to walk in customers at this time.

Sizing appointments will be available over the whole summer period during which you can try on uniform and purchase any items you require.

Appointments need to be pre-booked on our website <u>www.shotbowl.com</u> please see the attached instruction sheet.

Please book early as demand for appointments will be high – some dates are already fully booked.

Also, please be aware that although we normally quote 3-5 working days for delivery/collection of orders, from 12th August 2024 we may extend this up to 10-14 days, so please bear this in mind when planning your purchases for the start of the new term.

We will return to our full shop service from Tuesday 10th September 2024 onwards.

We are here to help as much as we can, so please get in touch if you need any additional assistance.
