We'd like to wish all our children and families a Happy New Year and are delighted to be welcoming a number of new children to Thurlby this term. We have had a lovely first week back with children quickly settling back into their school routines and enjoying lots of engaging and purposeful learning.

We'd like to just remind you all and advise our new parents of a few points:

- 1) Please ensure drinks bottles, that are to be taken into the classroom, contain water only.
- 2) Please do NOT park in the taxi/bus zone area at drop off and pick up time. This area is reserved for the vehicles bringing and collecting Thurlby children.
- 3) Children should not bring toys into school as this can cause disruption and/or upset if lost or broken. We also do not have any space to store them and the lockers are already too full.
- 4) Please ensure that the bag/backpack that your child brings into school is not too large. We have had big bags falling out of lockers as they will not close and this is a health and safety hazard for our children. Children in EYFS and KS1 should only bring their book bags to school along with their drinks bottle and pack up - if needed - in a small bag/backpack.
- 5) Thurlby is a nut free school, please ensure no products containing nuts are sent into school either in lunchboxes or as a snack. Many thanks.

<u>**Rhyme Time:**</u> A music and rhyme themed session where children can develop their language and communication skills and be signing along to their favourite songs and nursery rhymes.

Learning Through Play: This session provides a variety of activities for children to explore supporting children's changing needs and interests, the session offers an opportunity for parents, carers and children to discover and explore a wide range of play activities together, encouraging children's independence, confidence and social skills.

<u>Stay & Play under 1's:</u> This session aims to support developing babies to grow and learn. Activities will encourage babies to reach their unique developmental milestones, following their interests and curiosities.

<u>Little Explorers:</u> A sensory and messy play session providing materials of differing textures, temperatures and consistencies for children to explore, supporting their development and growing confidence

<u>Health Visitor Clinic:</u> There are many different health professionals within the Centre, delivering services such as midwifery and health visiting clinics. A health visitor clinic includes 6 - 8 week, 8 - 12 months and 2 - 2.5 year's assessments as well as 3 - 4 month contact.


