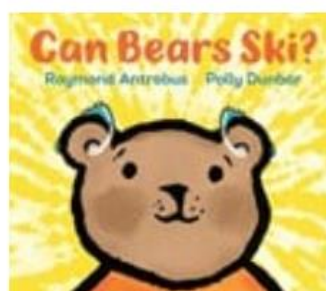
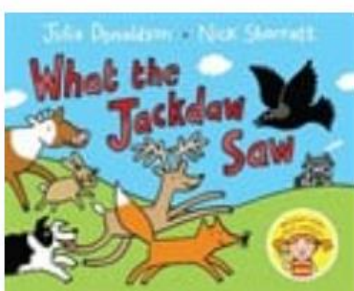
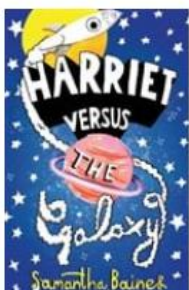
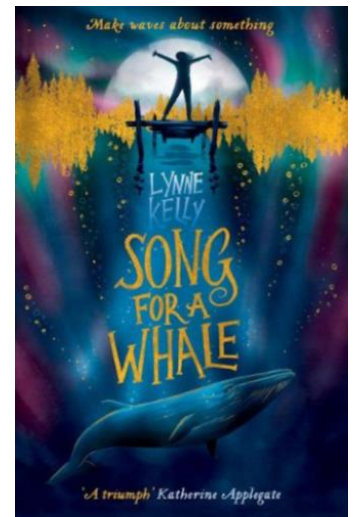
Our average attendance figure, for the week beginning 2nd May 2022, was 94%.
