Rowena demonstrated how to build a campfire and then the children had the opportunity to toast and eat rather sticky marshmallows. Once the fire was extinguished and the burnt wood had cooled, the children used the charcoal to draw nature inspired pictures and patterns on the paving slabs.

The children asked lots of thought-provoking questions and had the opportunity to see many elements of their Sikh learning in real life. Well done year 5!




# Year 6




