## Year 4 Visit to Burghley House

Year 4 had a wonderful day deepening their knowledge of Tudor life when they visited Burghley House on Wednesday. The day began with learning a Tudor dance and playing two Tudor games. After this, we had an interesting tour around parts of the house. The children were amazed by the opulent rooms, painted ceilings and ornate high beds.





After a picnic in the grounds, we discovered more about Tudor food and drink, while the children sat around a table laden with models of food reflecting the diet of rich and poor Tudors. The final activity involved the children making a Tudor pocket decorated with symbols from this time.



Year 4 were a delight; being described as 'exceptionally well-behaved' on more than one occasion during the day. Many thanks to the adult volunteers who gave their time to support the children and the class teacher for enabling this trip to take place.

### Year 6 Rounders Tournament

On Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July, nine of our Year 6 children attended a Rounders Tournament at Bourne Academy arranged by the School Games Organiser, Agilitas Sports. The children played in teams mixed with children from other schools in the local area, which gave them opportunity to meet new friends ahead of their move to secondary school this September.

A fantastic day was had by all and four Thurlby children came away with medals for first or second placed teams.



## Wildlife Club

During the penultimate session of wildlife club, the children worked collaboratively to create their own mandalas using natural materials. We discovered that the word 'mandala' means circle and the circular shape symbolises how nature doesn't begin or end but is always connected.



We welcomed a local representative from Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust to our final session. The children were challenged to a wildlife quiz and then were helped to explore and identify invertebrates in one of our beautiful oak trees. The children were presented with badges and a wildlife magazine to further their knowledge.

The children have been enthusiastic throughout all sessions, this has made the club a delight to organise and manage. Well done, children.

## Thurlby Runs

We're getting excited about the Thurlby Fun Run this Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July starting at 10am from Lawrance Park. Registration for the Run is from 9am, please arrive with plenty of time to do this. Some children may have brought registration forms home today and more details are on the poster below.
