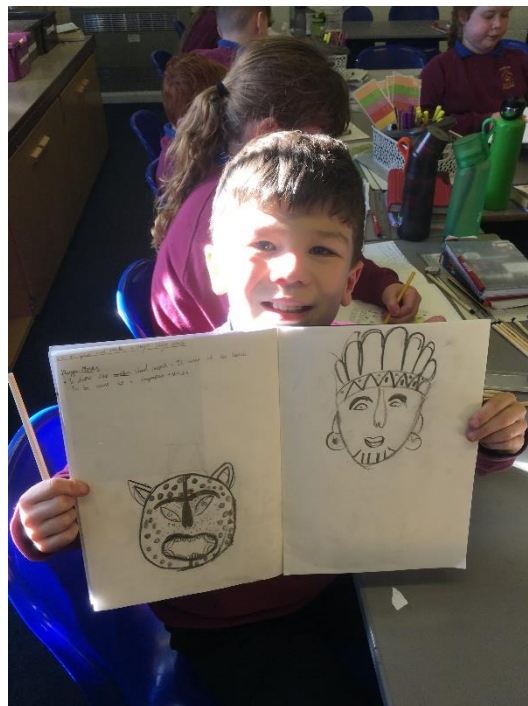
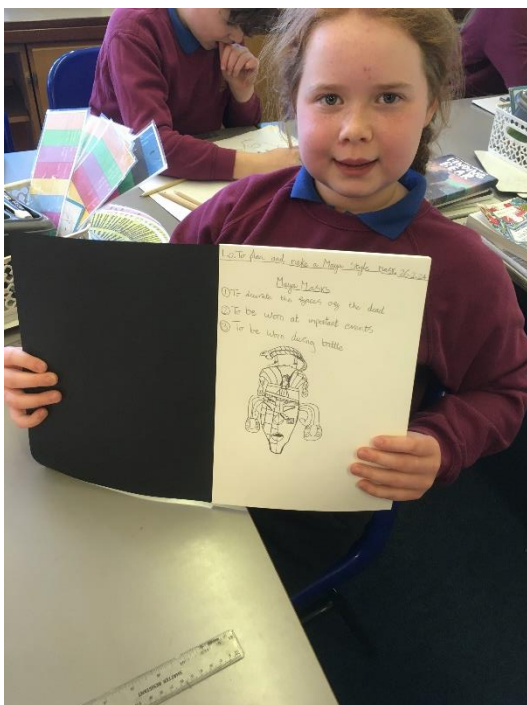


Hot Meals - Summer Term 1 - April 2024


