<u>Attendance</u>

Our average attendance figure, for the week beginning 8th November 2021, was 95.3%. We've seen a very slight rise in Covid cases this week, but the majority of absences are due to general illness.

Upper KS2 Science Workshop

On Friday 5th November, our Year 5 and 6 children were lucky to experience the wonderful world of science with Oundle School's STEM Roadshow, which was presented in collaboration with Imperial College London and supported by the OPEN Learning Partnership.

Aran and Ellie thought that the event was wonderful:

'A scientist from Imperial College London came and completed a workshop with us on astrophysics. The first experiment he did was to imitate the smoke rings created when a rocket blasts off. He did this by containing smoke inside a chamber and forcefully pushing it out to create the ring. It was incredible to see.

Next, he used a special camera, which could only see red light, to view the veins through his hand to show how satellites take photographs of planets in detail. After that, he made a bottle accelerate through the air by using a pinch of rocket fuel and some flammable alcohol and lit it on fire - it was amazing! We were also shown videos of failed and successful rocket landings.



The whole afternoon was absolutely astonishing!'

<u>Year 4</u>

Climate Change Assembly

This week, Year 4 and 5 took part in a special assembly organised by the National Physical Laboratory (NPL) based in London. The 'Measurement for our Planet: Climate Change Primary School Assembly' shone a light on how NPL are delivering solutions for climate science, emissions measurement and supporting innovation that will drive the decarbonisation of power, heat, manufacturing, agriculture and transport. The children were particularly interested to learn about hydrogen providing energy for vehicles because pure water is the only waste product. We listened to four different scientists who talked about their interest in science from an early age and their career paths.

<u>Year 5</u>

Peterborough Astronomical Society (PAS) are holding their Star Party at Sacrewell Farm this Saturday. PAS set their telescopes up to look at stars and constellations (weather permitting). They also create a planetarium-style talk and walk you through the sky at night, using apps and technology that is available to all and easy to use. As a special guest this year the Helpston Rocket Club will showcase a selection of their model rockets.

Doors open at 5.30pm and the event finishes at 9.15pm (last entry at 8pm) with a programme of talks and displays throughout the evening.

Entry costs £6 per adult and children under 16 can visit for free. Hot drinks and snacks will be available to buy in the café.

- 19 April 2022: parents can view the offered school online
