As you are aware, the traffic congestion/safety issue at drop off and pick up times is an ongoing concern for us all at school and our local residents.



We are always trying to find ways to ease the traffic flow at peak times of the day to ensure our children, accompanying adults and local residents remain safe. With this in mind, we have been liaising with Thurlby Methodist Chapel who have very kindly agreed to offer their car park to Thurlby Academy parents to use in the morning between 8.25am and 8.55am and after school from 2.45pm until 3.30pm.

This arrangement will be on a trial basis for one month starting from this Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June. We are really hoping this will be well utilised to enable the front of our school to be a safe, calm environment at the start and end of each school day. The safety of our children is paramount to us and this will be an excellent way to eliminate the concerns and complaints we receive from parents and residents regularly regarding poor driving and potentially dangerous situations.
