### Year 3

This week, Year 3 have been learning about the different types of rock. They completed an experiment with some Fruitella in which they squashed the sweets together gently to create a sedimentary rock. Then we applied more heat and pressure with our hands to form a metamorphic rock. Finally, we placed our metamorphic rocks in the microwave for 15 seconds to create an igneous rock once it cooled."


